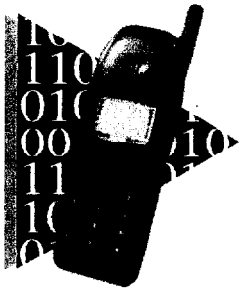

## 科大校友勇闖電訊業



電訊業近年在本港迅速發展，就以流動電話為例，自97年初起，多間PCS經營者相繼投入服務，部分經營者更推出固定月費無限次通話，甚至不設基本月費的促銷計劃，令用戶數目急劇增加。據電訊管理局公布的數字，至97年12月流動電話用戶總數已破二百萬大關，並繼續以每月逾10萬的速度增加。

在市場逐步開放下，電訊業確是個具高度競爭性的行業。我們特別走訪了三位校友，讓大家分享他們在電訊業的工作經驗，了解他們如何在瞬息萬變的環境中應付各種挑戰。

自 去年畢業後，張俊邦開始在瑞典公司 Allgon System 任職工程師，負責為本港及東南亞地區的流動電話經營商提供各類型的器件，如天線、放大器、濾波器等，並為這些公司提供技術支援。

俊邦在95年加入科大修讀電子工程碩士課程，專攻室內無線電系統設計。大學裡大、小的實驗室，以至「迂迴曲折」的走廊，都是他和同學們的實習場地。他現在的工作，則要克服流動電話信號在不同的室內環境，如大廈地庫、隧道、地鐵等地點的接收問題。

至於俊邦當時選擇來科大深造，就是看到了電機及電子工程學系濃厚的學術氣氛。

「科大電子工程的課程很實用，但節奏非常急速，同學們要追得上很吃力。若在求學期間能真正通過這些考驗，在工作上遇到的技術問題也就不難解決了。」

梁美寶94年從人文社會科學學院畢業後，便認定了公共關係是她理想的職業。三年來她在不同的公司任職公關，數月前加入訊聯電訊。去年12月公司宣佈和香港電訊合併後，她便成為香港電訊 CSL 的職員。

作為公司的公共關係經理，美寶不但替公司建立傳媒關係，亦在大型的產品推廣計劃中擔任協調公司各部門運作的角色。香港傳媒對電訊業的消息追得非常緊貼，每天美寶得翻閱報章，留意有關行內的新聞，預備隨時作出回應。

在大學期間美寶很享受校園生活，她是社三本科生宿舍的導師，兩年來得以和五樓姊妹們打成一片；此外美寶更參加話劇學會，在科大學生第一次公開演出的話劇「三心一意」中擔任導演。

美寶最懷念的科大老師是已故的錢新祖教授。「在我畢業時錢教授勸勉我在工作時要有適當的妥協，要尋找最能發揮自己的工作；並在不能妥協的時候便要找尋其他的發揮機會。這句話我至今仍然非常受用。」

市場推廣和銷售是電訊業重要的一環，亦聘請了很多科大不同學系的畢業生。許世裕的背景和上述兩位校友有點相似。95年在電機及電子工程學系畢業後，他發覺自己在社會科學方面的興趣更濃，便繼續在科大唸碩士學位。世裕現於香港電訊企業市場部任客戶經

理，銷售各類型的電訊產品及推廣不同的電訊服務，如國際長途電話服務、電話系統和電腦系統等。

他認為，大學教育提供重要的知識和理論基礎，令他在工作中能夠迅速吸收各種資訊。「畢業後，我選擇工作最主要是根據自己的興趣和能力。我看到有些同學只是根據學科而選擇行業，反而限制了自己的選擇範圍，這是很可惜的。」

98年2月開始，世裕在城市大學擔任兼任講師，籍此把自己的一些市場和銷售經驗和其他人分享。

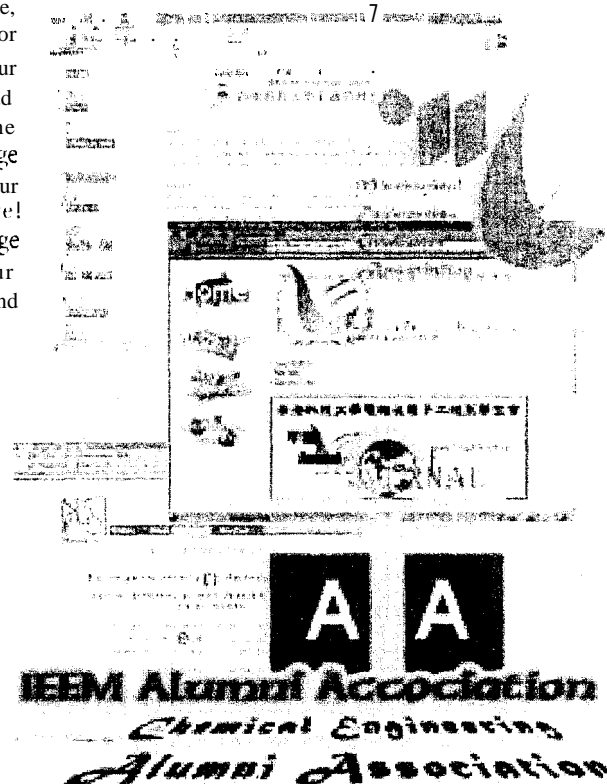
THE ACCOUNTING ALUMNI ASSOCIATION recently joined the family of UST alumni associations, bringing the total number of groups to 10.

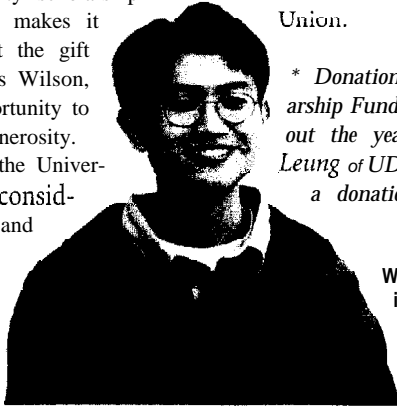
# Alumni Scholarship 1997/98
