

MEDIA REVIEW (NO.11/96)

This review is based on news clippings about UST. All information recorded here is as reported in the original articles. Names and terms are translated from the Chinese as best we can when official translations are not immediately available. South China Morning Post (SCMP), Hong Kong Standard (HKS) and Eastern Express (EE) are English newspapers. Enquiries can be made to Office of Public Affairs (ext. 6305 or 8555).

1. Shui On Group Ltd. donates \$25 M to UST to establish the Shui On Center for China Business and Management  
The press responded favourably to the donation ceremony held on 11/4. A total of 7 clippings (18-12/4) were received.
2. "Soy sauce, lipstick, charcoal" - works of artist Zhang Hongtu  
A total of 7 clippings (20-14/4) on this artist-in-residence activity were received.
3. Pres Woo attends SU forum on 22/4  
Eight papers (26-23/4) reported the forum and Pres Woo's views on politics and the media in HK.
4. UST and the row concerning the recent consultation sessions held by the Preparatory Committee  
A total of 13 clippings (23-12/4) were received. Some of the papers mentioned the comments of 3 UST people, Sir S Y Chung, Council Chairman, Pres Woo and Dr Y S Wong of BIOL. HK Commercial Daily (22/4) carried a related article on a UST student big character poster.
5. UGC proposes to cut subsidies to Universities in 1998-2001  
In a story on this, Ming Pao (22/4) mentioned that UST had decided to cut administrative costs by 5%. SCMP (23/4) also carried 2 stories on this.

Three papers (22-11/4) picked up our press release.

Both SCMP (18/4) and Ming Pao (4/4) reported that the UST team defeated the HKU team and won this year's competition.
