News Release

The Hong Kong University of Science and Technology announces today the establishment of three scholarships.

Zonta Club of Hong Kong East, HKUST's first scholarship donor, is contributing US \$10,000 per year (approximately HK \$78,000) for a three-year period with review regarding continuation of program at the third year. The scholarship will support international exchange programs at the University. The money will permit female HKUST students to study abroad. Under the Zonta scholarship programme, foreign exchange students from a cooperating university will take the place of the HKUST scholarship holders at HKUST.

Gammon Construction Company Limited, is providing the first engineering scholarships. They have committed funds to establish two three-year scholarships for Civil and Structural Engineering. These will provide three years of full tuition, residence fees, and a \$2,000 book allowance to two meritorious students. In addition, the donor will offer summer internships to the two scholarship holders, who also will have the opportunity of working for the Gammon Construction Company upon graduation.

The Chiap Hua Cheng Foundation is donating \$150,000 per year for scholarships and bursaries. \$90,000 are for scholarships based on academic merit of various departments including both post and undergraduate students. \$60,000 are for bursaries given to students who need financial assistance. The Cheng Foundation has been donating scholarships and bursary awards to tertiary education institutions since its establishment in 1977.

The University wishes to express its appreciation for these generous donations.
