LIBRARY EXHIBITIONS TO CELEBRATE HKUST'S 10th ANNIVERSARY

In celebration of the University's 10th anniversary, the Hong Kong University of Science and Technology (HKUST) Library has organized two concurrent exhibitions to open on 20 September 2001.

"Landmarks in Science and Technology, A Library Special Collection" will feature the Library's collection on the history of science. Epochal works representing monumental achievements in science and technology will be on display. These include Copernicus' *De Revolutionibus*, Archimedes's *Opera Omnia*, Galileo's *Discorsi e Dimostrazioni* and Newton's *Principia*. Most of them are first editions.

For the past ten years, HKUST Library has been recognized worldwide for its progressive adoption and application of information technology, its proactive and responsive services, and its well-focused and cohesive collections. "Library's First Ten Years" highlights some of the significant events of the Library in its short history.
