Mayor of Shanghai Visits HKUST

The Mayor of Shanghai, Mr Xu Kuangdi, accompanied by a seven-member delegation, will visit the Hong Kong University of Science and Technology today (28 July).

Members of the delegation are high-level government officials and business leaders of Shanghai, including:

Mr Wang Zukang, Chairman, Foreign Economic Relations and Trade Committee of the Shanghai Municipal People's Government.

The delegation will be received by Professor Chia-Wei Woo, President of the University; Professor Shain-Dow Kung, Vice-President for Academic Affairs; and Professor Eugene Wong, Vice-President for Research and Development. Deans, department heads, and faculty members at HKUST will also meet and discuss areas of cooperation with the delegation during their visit to the campus.

Mayor Xu and his delegation are visiting Hong Kong following a trip to San Francisco to celebrate the 15th anniversary of the Sister Cities Agreement between Shanghai and San Francisco. They are in Hong Kong for only two days, and will fly back to Shanghai right after a family-style dinner at the President's Lodge.
