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### **HKUST Organises Workshop on Microelectronics**

A free workshop concentrating on recent advances in microelectronic devices and technology will be held in the Hong Kong University of Science and Technology on 21 May, 1993. Its aim is to initiate a dialogue between academic institutions and industrial establishments in the area of microelectronics research and development.

The workshop is divided into four sessions: research activities in academic institutions, presentations by leading experts in the field, a panel discussion on the future of the microelectronics industry in the region, and a tour of the Microelectronics Fabrication Center (MFC) and the Materials Characterization and Preparation Center (MCPC) in HKUST.

Leading researchers from Intel Corporation, Stanford University, MIT and UCLA will report on the most recent development in microelectronics, while experts from local academic institutions and the Institute of Microelectronics in Singapore will introduce their research activities in the same field.

The workshop invites the participation of industrial scientists and engineers, students, faculty members and the interested public. The registration deadline is 6 May, 1993.
