English is the medium of instruction at HKUST. Applicants seeking admissions to our undergraduate programs may satisfy our English Language requirements through one of the following ways:

HKDSE English Language	Level 3
IELTS (International English Language Testing System)	Overall Band: 6.0
TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) Internet-based test (iBT)	Score: 80

CREDIT TRANSFER

Students need to complete a minimum of 120 credits before graduation.

Holders of a recognized local sub-degree may be granted up to 60 advanced credits (50% of total credits required for graduation).
